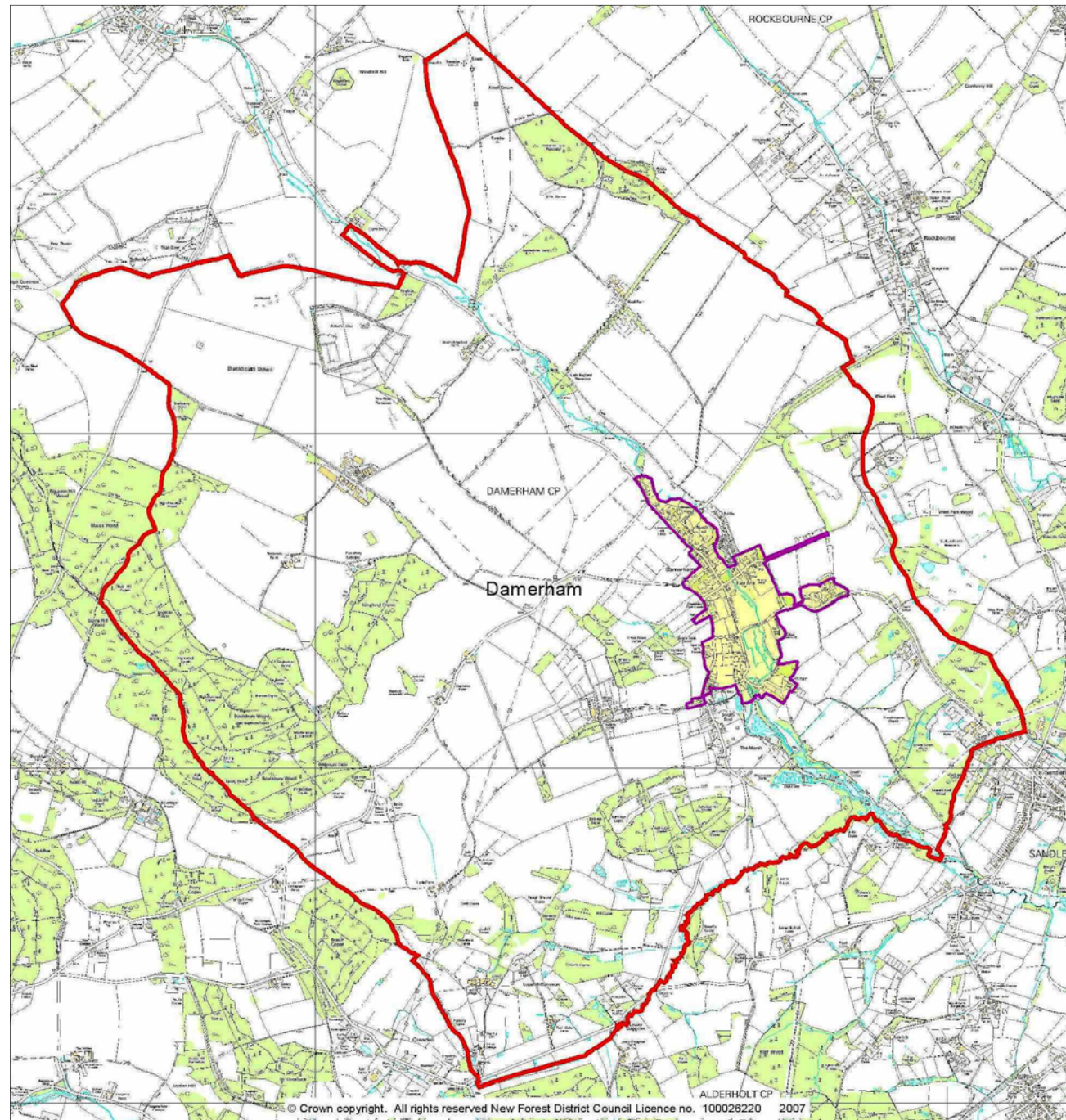


## The Parish of Damerham

<b>Shopping</b>	The "Village Store" in Sandleheath is open daily from 7.00 a.m. to 6.30 p.m. Monday to Saturday and Sunday from 9.30 to 11.00 a.m. It incorporates a Sub-Post Office - Open Monday, 9.00 am to 16.30 pm and Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday & Friday. 9.00 am to 13.00 pm. <b><u>The Post Office is closed on Saturdays.</u></b> The nearest town for general shopping is Fordingbridge which has a wide range of shops including a Co-Op, a Tesco Express, butchers, bakers, several hair-dressers, fast food outlets, pubs & restaurants and DIY shops - and many others. Note - Some shops in Fordingbridge close for their half-day at lunch time on Thursdays. There is a small shop attached to the Garage in East End which sells soft drinks, ice cream and confectionery.
<b>Waste Collection And Recycling</b>	Household rubbish is collected on Friday in most of the village, although it is Thursday for Lopshill, Lower Daggons, a couple of South End properties, The Common & Bouldsbury. Recycling bags (paper, cardboard, cans, plastic bottles etc.) are collected on the same day.  Glass Bottle collection dates are advised in the Parish Pump
